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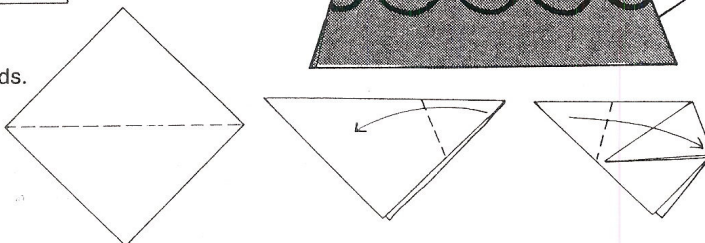
Turtle

**Materials:**

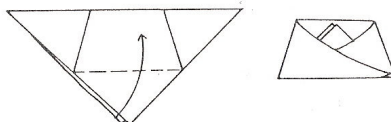
Use a 5" (13cm) square of green paper.

**Steps to follow:**

1. Fold the basic folds.



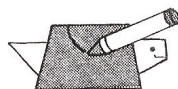
2. Turn up the two points. Press them under the two flaps.



3. Fold back one tip for the turtle's tail. Then fold back the other tip. Fold back the point for the turtle's head.



4. Add an eye and a smile plus texture lines on the shell with crayon or felt pen.

**Uses:**

- Paste turtle to a sheet of construction paper. Invite students to write facts about turtles. Paste the writing paper on the back of the construction paper.
- Make two turtles: one facing left and one facing right. Paste them to a sheet of construction paper. Paste cartoon bubbles above their heads. What does one turtle say to another?
