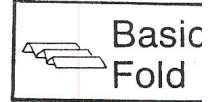
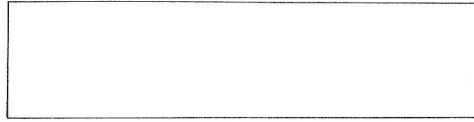


Alligator



Materials:

Use a 9" x 3" (22.8 x 7.5cm) rectangle of green paper.

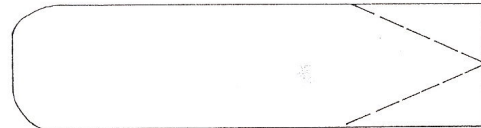


Steps to follow:

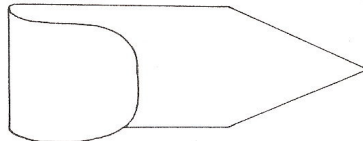
1. Round the corners on one end of the rectangle.



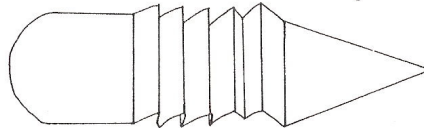
2. Cut the other end of the rectangle to a point.



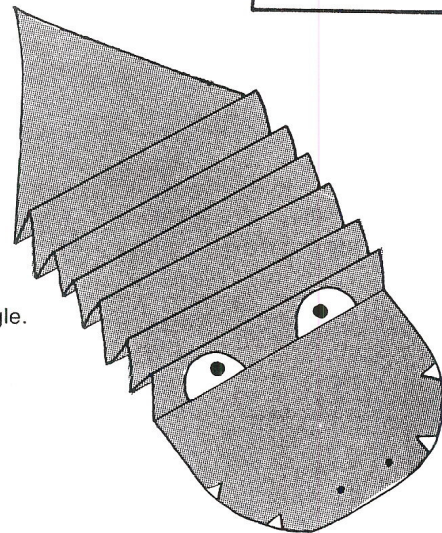
3. Fold back the snout section.



4. Accordion fold the middle of the alligator's body.

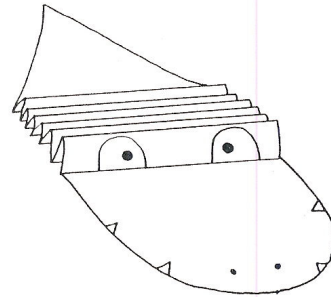


5. Add facial details with black crayon or felt pen.

Uses:

- Pin these alligator's all around the bulletin board. Display student work in the center and add a caption that reads "Gator Greats".
- Paste the tail and base of alligator's snout to blue paper. The mouth of the alligator must still open up. Cut out a paper fish and paste it on the blue paper under alligator's snout.
